

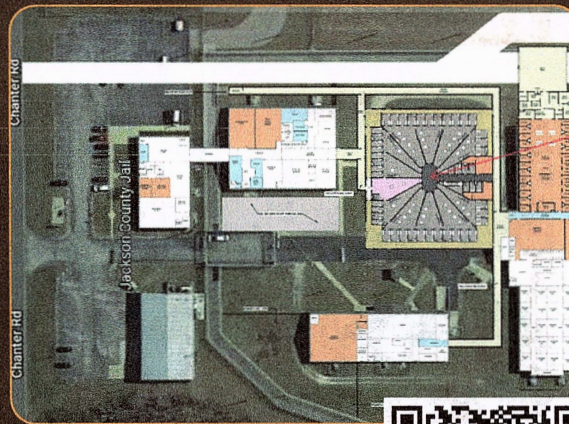
# WHY DOES OUR COMMUNITY NEED A JAIL MILLAGE?

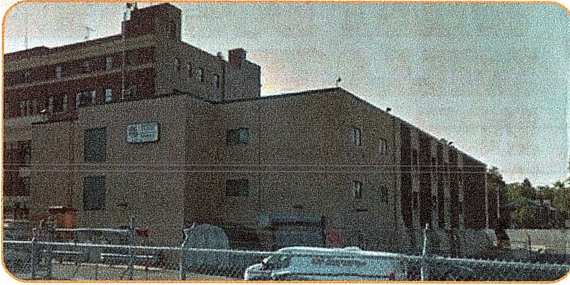
